Sat., April 10: Handler/Obstacle Focus Fundamentals. Open to dogs of all levels that are doing all obstacles full height.

Sun., April 11: Novice/Open Course skills and Handling. Dogs must be competing in at least the novice level. If you haven't worked with Stuart before, you must audit the Sat. seminar.

Mon., April 12: Masters Course skills and Handling. Dogs must be competing at the Masters level. If you haven't worked with Stuart before, you must audit the Sat. seminar.

About Stuart. Stuart Mah has been one of the nation's leading and innovative agility personalities for almost two decades. He is also considered one of the foremost authorities on course design and course analysis.

Stuart has been an 8-time member of US international agility teams. He is also a 13-time USDAA national championship finalist and 5-time AKC finalist. His dogs have earned the highest titles in several agility organizations including 5 ADChs and 3 MACHs. They have also earned 4 individual national champion titles (USDAA and AKC), 2 national team titles, and a world championship title in 2006.

Stuart is currently competing with his 8 year old Border Collie, Qwik (ADCH, MACH). Qwik finished his USDAA Agility Dog Championship in exactly one year from the date he entered his first trial in starters. Qwik's accolades include a gold medal at the 2004 Purina Incredible Dog Challenge and several silver medals at the 2004 and 2005 ESPN Great Outdoor Games. He was also on the winning team at the 2005 USDAA Dog Agility Masters Team finals in Scottsdale, AZ. In 2006, Qwik became a world champion winning two gold medals at the IFCS World Championships in the Agility Biathlon and Power and Speed events.

Stuart has judged for all of the major US agility organizations. In 1991 he was inducted into the USDAA agility Hall of Fame and in 1995 was the USDAA's Agility Person of the Year. He was also designated as an Agility Pioneer by USDAA in 2005. He has served on agility advisory boards for both USDAA and AKC.

Stuart has written articles for numerous magazines and is also the author of several books on agility, including "Fundamentals of Course Design for Dog Agility" and "Course Analysis for Agility Handlers". A new book, "Fundamentals of Course Design and Analysis: Specialty Classes" is due out soon. He has also worked with television and media groups such as PBS, Animal Planet, and National Geographic about agility.

Agreement to Hold Harmless Waiver and Assumption of Risk

I understand that attendance at a dog obedience/agility training class or club related event is not without risk to myself, members of my family, guests who might attend, or to my dog, because some of the dogs to which I will be exposed may be difficult to control and may be the cause of injury even when handled with the greatest of care.

I hereby waive and release Y2K9s Dog Sports Club, hereinafter referred to as the "Club", its employees, officers, members, directors, and agents from any and all liability of any nature for injury or damage which I or my dog may suffer, including, specifically but without limitation, any injury or damage resulting from the action of any dog. I expressly assume the risk of such damage or injury while attending any training session, or any other function, of the Club, or while on the training grounds or the surrounding area thereto.

In consideration of and as inducement to the acceptance of my application for training membership by the Club, I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless this Club, its employees, officers, members, directors, and agents from any and all claims, or claims by any member of a family or any other person accompanying me to any training session or function of the Club, or while on the grounds or the surrounding area thereto, as a result of any action by any dog, including my own.

By participating in classes or events at Y2K9s, I understand that both I and/or my dog(s) will be working with, exposed to or otherwise be in the presence of other dogs. I understand that neither Y2K9s, its Board of directors, officers, its members, and/or its instructors warrant or otherwise insure my safety or the safety of my dog during events, classes or periods proceeding or following events or classes hosted by Y2K9s.

In the event that this hold harmless agreement is a condition of my participation at Y2K9s and me for the privilege of participating in events and/or classes at Y2K9s.
